Proposed By-Laws Amendments Executive Summary August 23, 2019

Since the revised draft bylaws were circulated in the spring, a few additional changes have been made. The original proposed changes and some additional clarification on the proposed amended bylaws is summarized below.

Proposed Changes:

Correct various typographical errors and add clarity.

Substantive changes include:

Article II
Section 5

Past Presidents (going forward) will only receive exemption from dues for 5 years after they complete their board service.

Section 6

Clarify non-residency membership requirements.

Article II
Section 7 and 8

Clean up language defining 25 and 40 year members.

Article III
Section 2

Dues shall be set forth in the House Rules and set by the Board. Additional language was also added clarifying the 5 year dues exemption for past presidents going forward (no longer a life exemption).

Section 4.

Food and Beverage minimums shall be set by Board and published in House Rules.

Section 7.

Addition: Any member receiving four notice of delinquency in payment on their annual dues, house account or minimum during a Club fiscal year may be terminated by the Board from

Membership effective immediately upon written notice to their address of record with the Club.

Article IV

Section 1.

Ballots will be mailed and may be cast by mail if received by the Club by the date of the Annual Meeting. Ballots must be delivered by the opening of the meeting and cannot be sent by fax or e-mail.

Section 6.

The President will cast a second sealed vote for the Board that will only be opened and counted in the event of a tie vote and the announcement of elections winner.

Article VI

Section 1.

Members running for the Board shall not actively campaign within the Club or otherwise interfere with the other Members in their enjoyment of the Club.

Section 3.

Confirms that ballots must be returned to the Club prior to the opening of the annual meeting.
