Dear Valued Members.

The Board of Directors wants to reach out to you to keep you up to date with events and developments under way so far this year at the Club. We have received feedback and recommendations from our Annual Meeting last November and direct discussions with members.

First, Thank you for your membership of the HRC and for using it for dining and entertainment. Our focus is to address membership numbers and increase usage of the Club by current members. Membership totals have been steady over the last 10 years; however, members are moving into the 25- and 40-year classes which translate into a lower amount of dues collected annually. The Club has traditionally attracted new members through current members, which is on the decline. The Membership Committee has met to discuss possibilities for getting new membership numbers up. Special guest speaker events are being developed as we move forward into the year; the April dinner with our guest speaker was a huge success! Euchre and winetasters groups gather on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday evenings once a month to increase business during the week. The Club has hosted local Chamber of Commerce events, and we are looking at other local clubs for possible sources for new members. New Membership meetings have been scheduled each month for the remainder of the year. Our goal is to add between 25 and 30 new members this year and we have already signed up 10 new members.

Improvements to our facility over the last 4 years include carpeting replacement, front log replacements, new foyer windows and doors, all rooftop HVAC replacements, new hot water boiler and major beverage cooler repairs. These investments in our facility have left us with a small loss in our income statement last year. Our goal is to turn this around and to plan funds for two remaining improvement projects for the roof and parking lot. We hear from members that we should try to avoid an assessment.

Another factor is that fewer members are coming in for dining, which is a trend that began after Covid. This is the critical piece to the puzzle that is missing. We need members to come in and use the Club. Also take a moment to update your contact information as well as email info since we use Constant Contact, Facebook and Instagram for advertising and keeping you in the loop.
